DEVELOPMENTS

OSCAR BC is working on some big projects and new features:

- We are working towards the new CDA-format standard for lab reports in BC.
- We're working with Doctors of BC and the Practice Support Program (PSP) to support physician practices with simplified reporting functions that help with panel cleanup and ongoing panel maintenance. Look for details from PSP and GPSC about upcoming enhancements to this project and funding details to remunerate physicians for their time with this work.
- We have been working with PHSA on the Care Connect project
- We've created a new billing dashboard feature to help track CDM billings and more

We have several other exciting projects about to start that we'll tell you about in the next issue.

3RD PARTY APP'S

Many OSCAR Users are being approached by vendors offering APP's that connect to your OSCAR EMR or to your desktop providing scheduling, appointment bookings, reminders, locating a physician, and other similar services.

As the name implies, the program interfaces with the EMR to retrieve data needed for the service. Some are more expensive than others, depending on the features.

A WORD OF CAUTION, be CAREFUL when choosing to work with one of services. There is no such thing as a free lunch, or an APP for that matter. The service may be touted as free or low cost but they can consume valuable staff time and in some cases incompatibility issues with the EMR.

OSCAR BC has developed a 3rd Party Integration Statement that requires vendors to provide disclosure on what the product does and how it connects with OSCAR.

We suggest you contact your OSP before agreeing to install a 3rd Party Application.
