The Practice Support Program (PSP), funded by Doctors of BC and the BC Government through the General Practice Services Committee (GPSC), provides a range of activities and supports to help physicians and medical office assistants (MOAs) build and enhance their practices.

Physicians who have completed the phases of Panel Management can use their panel data to reach out proactively to their patients and ensure they receive the care they need.

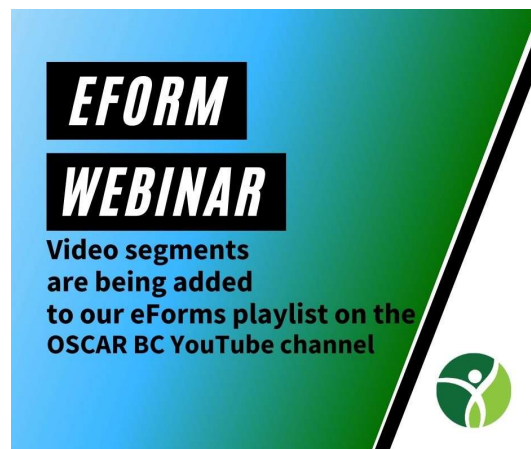
Areas of outreach may include:

- Proactively reaching out to patients who need routine chronic disease management care.
- Running reports of upcoming medication expiry and doing outreach to renew/check-in with patients.
- Checking in with patients over 60 who may be at increased risk.

Physicians who haven't participated in panel management now have an opportunity to improve the efficiency of their practices while being compensated for their activities. Learnings include: how to easily track billings, building better workflows, identifying and clarifying roles and responsibilities of practice teams, and learning how to optimize EMR data.

1. Special Authority Rivaroxaban 2021

This form has been on the beta testing side for 2 months and has now been moved to the permanent side [here](#).

2. Controlled Substance Prescribing eForm (Opioid Use Form)

From PHS Health Care, PHS Community Services Society: "We just completed a major revision of an eForm borrowed from the BC Centre for Substance Use, and want to share it with the OSCAR community in BC. It saves so much hand-writing!"

This eForm is designed to print directly onto individual Folio pages carefully removed from the controlled substance pads printed by the College. These pages are then fed into our printers by hand.

Revised for us by WELL, it works with OSCAR Classic and OSCAR Professional. We have named it 1.c OUD eform in our system so it appears near the top of our eForm list. Other users may name it whatever works for them."

3. Canadian Pain and Regenerative Institute

This clinic offers MSP and non-MSP covered services to assist in care of patients with chronic and pre-chronic MSK-related pain. There are eForms for medical and rehabilitation referrals.

4. MIDAS: Migraine Disability Assessment

The MIDAS (Migraine Disability Assessment) questionnaire was put together to help measure the impact headaches have on a patient's life. The information is also helpful for primary care providers to determine the level of pain and disability caused by the headaches and to find the best treatment. The eForm calculates with a button and highlights the appropriate Grade, Definition, and Score.

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5. MTOQ-5 Migraine Treatment Optimization Questionnaire (acute therapy)

This is a validated tool to use patient-reported outcomes to:

- Identify patients with an inadequate treatment response
- Identify patients who require a change of their current acute treatment
