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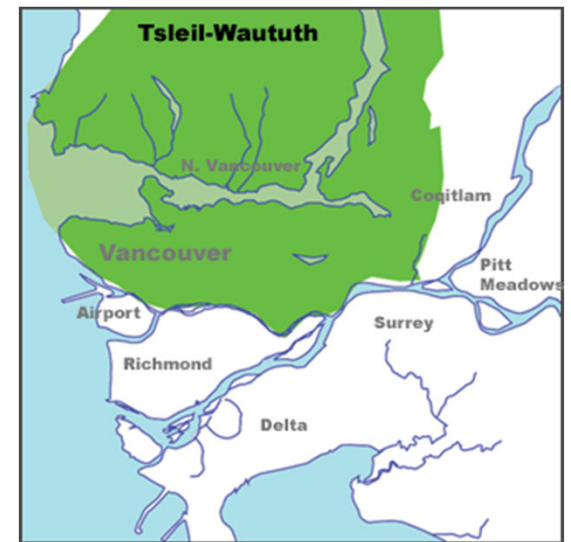

- A secure, view-only Electronic Health Record (EHR)
- Provides patient-centric information to support healthcare providers in their delivery of patient care
- Offers authorized healthcare providers 24/7 access to an integrated, provincial view of clinical information

1. Find patient record in OscarEMR
2. Click the 'CareConnect' button
3. Sign on with BC Services app on your phone
4. Acknowledge correct patient

within 20 seconds

② Secure Website

1. Open CareConnect website
2. Sign on with BC Services app on your phone
3. Search for patient using PHN
4. Acknowledge correct patient

within 40 seconds
