eForms were the #1 requested training topic identified by our subscribers. This is a free webinar with 2 main segments.

**9 am - 10 am: The Provincial eForms Solution** repository for electronic forms is driven by the vision of "all healthcare forms, always up-to-date, all points of service, pre-populated where possible, and delivered electronically." Integration with the OSCAR EMR is planned for later in 2021. This will allow real-time retrieval of up-to-date forms and electronic transmission of completed forms directly from your EMR, improve form availability and the end-to-end form workflow for both clinicians and form owners, provide instant on-demand updates to existing forms. It will help "axe the fax" in BC!




#### VIRTUAL CBT SKILLS GROUPS AVAILABLE NOW

The Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) Skills Group program is an MSP-funded, physician-led program for adult patients (17.5-75 years old) who want to learn practical tools to improve their mental health. It's a self-management course targeted at anxiety, depression and stress that integrates basic neuroscience concepts with introductory mindfulness and cognitive behavioural therapy teaching. It is delivered as an eight-week series of 90-minute group medical visits, with 15 patients per group. Patients learn practical tools to recognize, understand and manage patterns of feeling, thinking and behaving. They learn to be conscious of their choices as they respond to life stressors, and explore options for living a fuller, richer life, more aligned with what they value most.

Physicians across the province can now refer to the CBT Skills Group program directly and patients enrol and participate online, with little to no waitlist. Referral forms are now embedded in <u>OSCAR</u>.

# 2. Surgical Patient Optimization Collaborative (SPOC)

"This form was generated in the course of the "Surgical Patient Optimization Collaborative" (SPOC) project currently being piloted in Campbell River with some DoBC / PSP support. It is expected that other health authorities will soon have their very own versions of SPOC forms. This is in the context of the current enthusiasm around perioperative medicine and "ERAS" principles. The idea is that FPs will work with their patients to address a series of specific concerns brought up by the surgeons/anaesthetists to "optimize" them in the weeks and months while they are wait-listed for surgery. Concerns such as glycemic control, obesity, OSA, substance use or smoking etc. FPs then are required to report back to the preoperative team in a specific format, hence this "SPOC" eForm.

The second allows you to choose: 1) the provider 2) ICD 9 codes 3) age greater than 4) age less than and 5) not seen since - date."

# **14. Cancer Genetics and Genomic Laboratory Myeloid Tumor Testing March 2020**

"This eForm is clearly only going to be used by a select few. However, others may be interested in some of the code. I have created a function called changeAndCheck. This "toggles" the "required" attribute of a text field that follows an X box ( when the Xbox is checked or unchecked ) and reports on the validity of the text field (is the required field filled?). It requires that the diad be named after the fashion "AnXbox" and "AnXbox Text" to work (as with all javascript it is case sensitive). It is designed to be used multiple times in an eForm to simplify and decrease coding. If you have Xbox fields that require more information if they are checked (requires interpreter - language; Specimen type Other - specify) this coding would make sure that the fields get filled. There is also an "onbeforeprint" validity check for the entire form. This doesn't actually prevent you from printing the form, but when you go to print it, pop-ups will occur and fields will be highlighted in red. You can then cancel the printing and go back and fill out the fields (or I suppose you could print it anyways). You can not submit a form if the required fields are not filled. If you really don't want to fill them, put a space in them."
