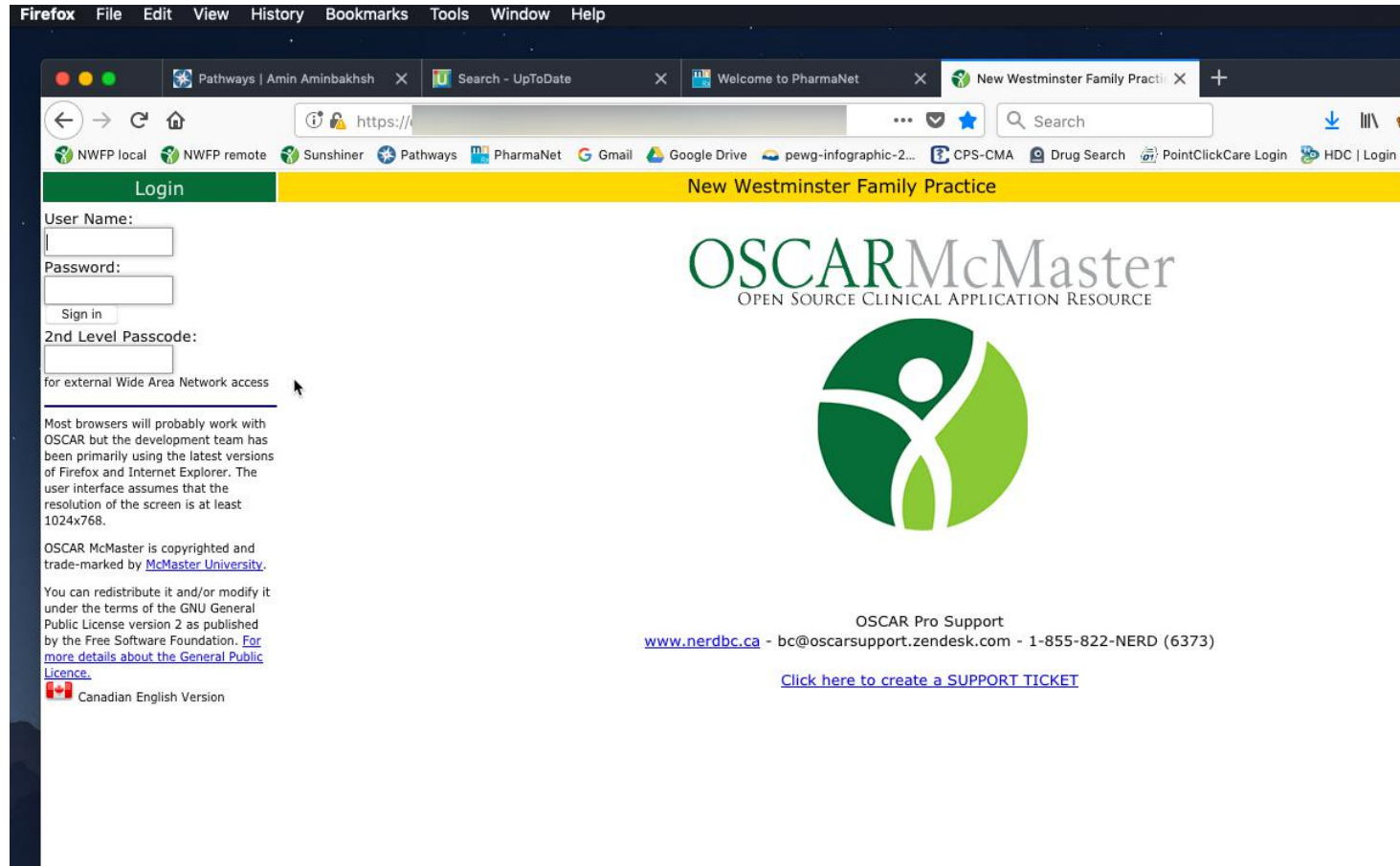

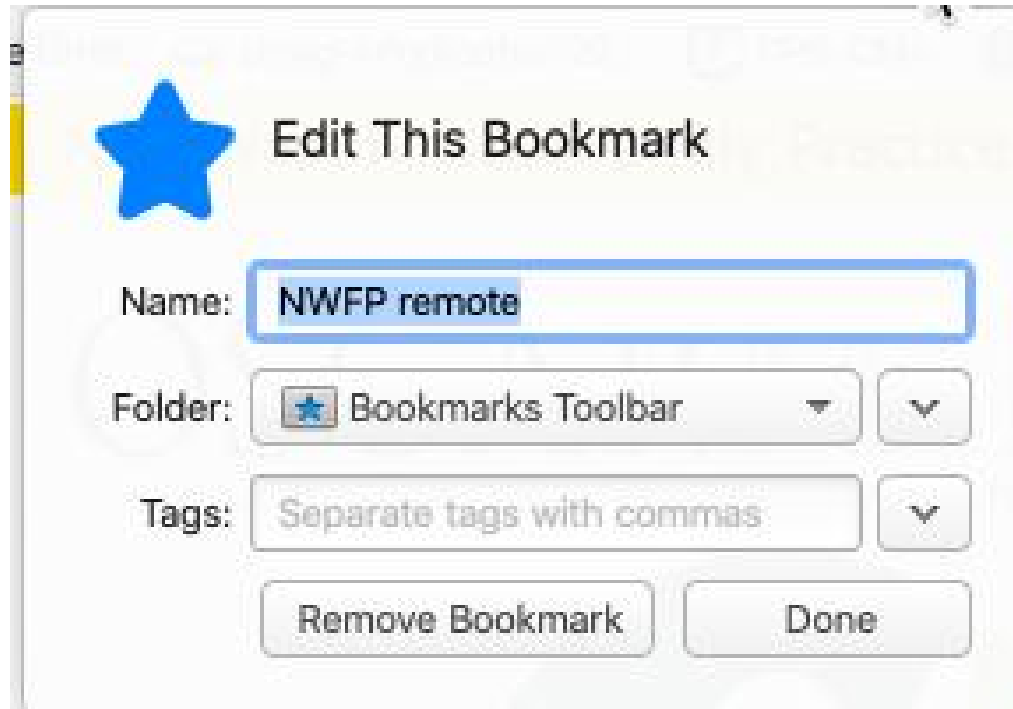

Removing Headers and Footers


Chosen solution

You can set the default header and footer for your printer from the Firefox configuration page. To do so, please follow these steps:

1. Type `about:config` in the Firefox location bar
2. Click the *I'll be careful* button
3. Type *header* in the page's search bar

You should see a group of strings that are named:

- `print.printer_[Printer Name].print_headerleft`
- `print.printer_[Printer Name].print_headercenter`
- `print.printer_[Printer Name].print_headerright`



By default the strings will have a value `&T` for page title, `&U` for the page's URL, `&PT` for page counter and `&D` for print date.

To erase the header, simply change the value of the above strings to nothing. To do the footer, repeat the process with *footer* typed into the search bar.

Warning: Only change the settings for the printer that you desire to have no header/footer.

Note: If you want to bring the header/footer back, simply add the values back into the strings.

Search for headers and change the preset/default to blanks. Do the same for footers.

FireFox, Presbyopia and !

If you are font-challenged – use **Ctrl/Cmd +** or **Ctrl/Cmd –** to zoom in or out.
Ctrl/Cmd 0 (zero) resets zoom to default size.

Keystroke shortcuts work:

Ctrl A – highlight all for cutting, copying

Ctrl C – to copy highlighted text

Ctrl V – to paste copied text

Ctrl X – to delete highlighted text N.B. does not copy!

Ctrl Z – undo last action – undo that delete! Use with caution – has limits!

Double click on word – highlights entire word

Triple click word – highlights entire line

Search for headers and change the preset/default to blanks. Do the same for footers.

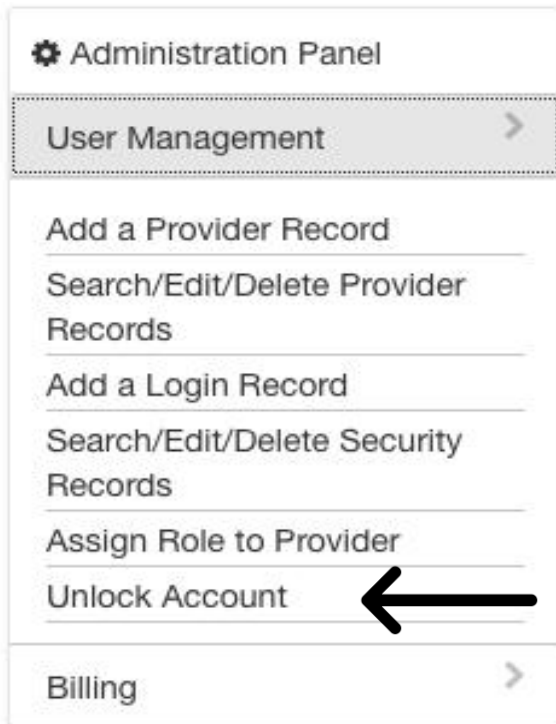
Administration/User Management/Provider Record



The more you double/triple book in your schedule - the wider the page. It can get unwieldy. For cancellations, consider adding the original booked time and the time/date of cancellation into the reason for visit, and moving the appt to the bottom of the schedule. **DO NOT DELETE** cancelled appointments (CMPA suggestion).

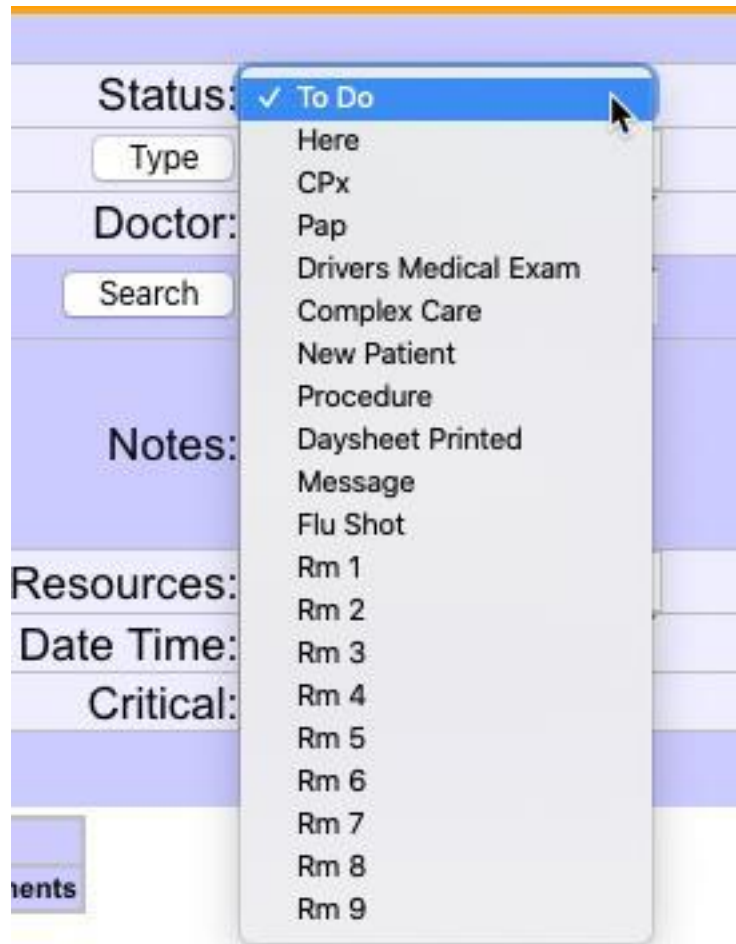

Search patient in usual manner (Last Name, First Name). Can add any name, even if not in system (no chart of course). Add a **REASON** for visit whenever possible. DO NOT use any line-feeds in this box. Block off a segment with "**Not Book**" – this will block any future attempt to book in that slot. Try the "Critical" button. Update **STATUS** as patient flows through office. Consider an alert status.




COPD ASSESSMENT AND ACTION PLAN

The assessment of COPD requires a multifactorial approach. **Spirometry** is required for diagnosis and is useful for assessment of severity of airway obstruction. However after having established a spirometric diagnosis, management decisions should be individualized and guided by the severity of symptoms and disability, as measured by the MRC scale.

You have been diagnosed with COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease)

COPD has 2 states:

1. You are stable. You are not short of breath, can do daily activities, can cough up mucus easily, sleep well, and are able to exercise. Or.....
2. You are having a flare up.

How to tell if you are having a flare up

A flare up may occur after you get a cold, get run down, are exposed to air pollution, or during very hot/cold weather weather. There are 3 things that define a flare up:

1. Increased and persisting shortness of breath from your usual level. **(Consider using just Prednisone to manage symptoms)**
2. Worsening of usual cough. **(Probably require both antibiotics AND Prednisone)**
3. Change in usual sputum: colour change from white to yellow, green, or rust; increase in amount of sputum.

You may also have fever, fatigue or low energy; feel a change in mood; or have chest x-ray changes noted prior to a flare-up.

If 2 or more of these symptoms persist for 24 hours or more, do the following:

☒ Take your rescue inhaler 2-4 puffs as needed (up to 4-6 times per day) for shortness of breath.

☒ Call for an appointment with your family doctor for a check up and medication review.
