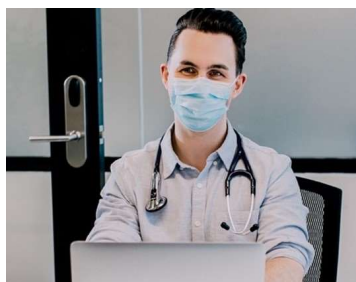

Register for CareConnect - Steps to Acquire Access

CareConnect is the provincial view-only Electronic Health Record.

Eligible clinics and care provider groups can access CareConnect through their internet browser or a direct link through their EMR. You can get quicker access to your patient's health history, spend less time tracking down reports and results, identify other clinicians involved in your patient's care, and more.

These are the set-up steps:

1. [Set up](#) a BC Services Card (approx 5 min) *
2. [Register](#) yourself and your clinic for secure web access to CareConnect

Note: A BC Services Card is required to have access to PRIME in Pharmanet as well, so you may have already completed that step.

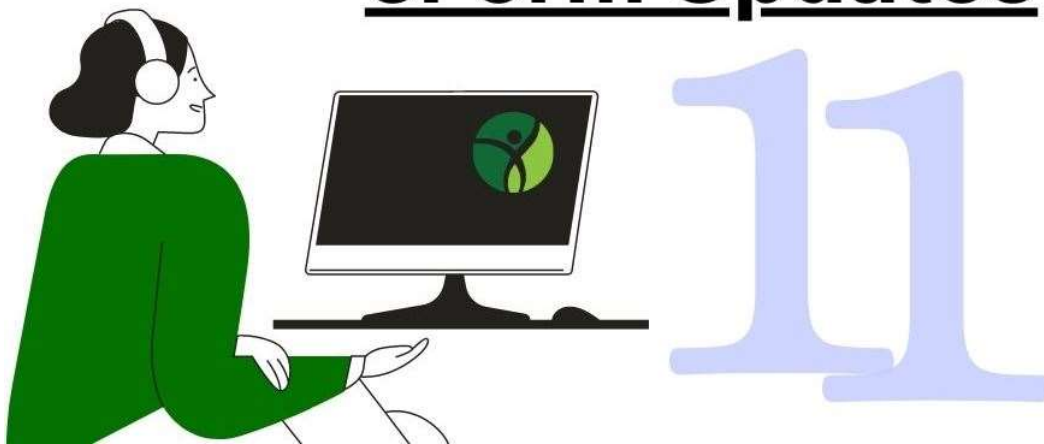

eForms & Forms Updated in Feb and Mar 2021

1. Tri-Cities Infant Feeding Clinic

2. Vancouver Coastal Health Home and Community Care Referral

3. VCH Adult ADHD Clinic Referral eForm

4. The Medical Weight Management Program (Coquitlam)

This referral form has been updated by Dr. John Yap. The clinic is run by Dr. Michael Lyon. This eForm has been updated and posted [here](#) and [here](#).

The additional eForms enhance the functions. The Pt Summary eForm may already be in your system. It may be under a different name - e.g. Primary Care Provider Patient Summary. If that's the case, you may have to adjust the line to reflect the name of your Pt Summary eForm.

5. FH Stroke Prevention Clinic 2020 (Two Options)

a) The eForm for the stroke prevention clinic has been updated to include code to stop you from submitting if the required fields are not present. This referral eForm has the print&submit button removed and now has code to remind you to submit after you have printed. The central intake number has changed. No more ABCD2 scoring to assess stroke risk stratification - though must include a general reference to acuity description.

7. The BC Pap Smear form

"The update to the pap smear form allows you to set a tickler to check if the results have returned. V28 also has the Tickler loop closer if you wish to set a reminder to ensure results return within a specified time." Note by Dr. John Yap

8. Pharyngitis Risk Score - Modified Centor Score Updated for 2021

This eForm was updated by Dr. Gunther Klein. It is a straight HTML eForm, there is no image component. This form is UPLOADED not imported. The 2018 version has been removed.

10. ECOG Performance Scale

11. Lower Extremity Functional Score (LEFS)

Used fairly regularly for referral to Joint Replacement Programs. Created by Günther Klein, notes by GK:

- "I tweaked the CSS print media script to render a one-page paper questionnaire for patients to fill out on a clipboard.
- Rearranged the questionnaire to make it less confusing for patients to understand (we are asking about "difficulty" but points are allocated per "level of function")
- v2 push-pulls "LEFS" from measurements, and has embedded measurement setup instructions.
- v3 has measurements disabled (commented out) for those that don't use measurement"

NOTICE 1: Changes to the Print and Submit Button in eForms

"After some discussion amongst some of the designers and consumers of eForms Dr. Yap and I have decided we are going to remove the print and submit button from our present and future eForms.

While we certainly enjoy the convenience of a 1 click solution there have been increasing problems with this button. Initially this was compensated for by increasing the delay between print and submit, but even that solution has started to fail of late.

We have been told that this problem will only get worse moving forward with changes to the latest browsers. Unfortunately that leaves the users potentially open to incomplete documentation and the potential for medico-legal issues.

One work around that has been commonly used is the following:

After clicking the Print and Submit button - if the form prints but does not close - this indicates that it still has not submitted. You would need to click the submit button a second time. Closing the window or tab is NOT the right thing to do as the form never submits and is lost. You MUST click the submit button a SECOND time. This would be the approach for eForms that have not been updated.

Moving forward, Dr Yap and I will be removing the print and submit button from our eForms (or never adding it in the first place). We realize that increases the number of clicks and we apologize. If/When better code comes along such that the print and submit button can be re-established, we will try to incorporate that in our forms. But for now, for safety sake, we will only have the Submit, Reset, and Print buttons at the bottom of our forms. Again our apologies but we feel it is the safest thing we can do currently."
